The guidelines for this event are purposely open ended to accommodate all interested students and applicants are encouraged to be as creative as possible, as long as the finished product meets the criteria of both promoting and preserving historic Route 66. Projects may include, but are not limited to the following submissions:

One college level scholarship amounts will be \$500 paid directly to the college by Route 66 Podcast.

Please note the following requirements:

- Students must be attending a two or four year college, university, or technical school in the fall of the 2021 – 2022 academic year after receiving award.
- Award will be paid directly to the college
- Minimum GPA at time of application is 2.5

- One letter of recommendation from
- Winning college applicant must agree to phone interview prior to award being dispersed
- Application submitted/postmarked by June 30, 2021

The award will be sent directly to the college or university.
